National Research on Investigations 2nd edition -

In a large scale study, single-grade comparative analyses of the data showed that *Investigations* students did as well or significantly better than comparison students using other curricula on both standardized tests of mathematical achievement and on researcher-designed assessments. At one site the *Investigations* students outperformed the comparison group at each grade level and at the other site they performed statistically the same.

Limitation- This study should be viewed as a first step towards understanding the impact of the second edition. Several factors limit conclusions that can be drawn from this study. The curricular materials were not in final form, measures of classroom practice were based on self-report, and high attrition rates limited the power and complexity of the statistical analyses. However, the results do provide evidence of efficacy.

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
